Workshop 1 Exercise 2

Make a web page that looks like the following when it loads:

A text input box:

Some radio buttons with Cat checked by default:
 Dog Cat Mouse

Some checkboxes with Power steering and Air conditioning selected by default:
 Power steering Air conditioning Leather upholstery Automatic transmission

Now a dropdown list box from which only one option can be selected, with Green selected by default:
 ▼

Now a dropdown list from which more than one option may be selected, with Small and Medium selected by default:

You will have to use `<form>`, `<input>` and `<select>` elements.

The start tag of your `<form>` element should have an attribute named **method** with the value "get" and an attribute named **action** with the value "http://www.brics.dk/ixwt/echo".

By making appropriate selections in your form and then pressing the submit button, generate a web page that looks like the following:
